

The Mizzou New Play Series, under the artistic direction of Dr. David Crespy, is a key part of our Writing for Performance Program which not only has received the Region V Kennedy Center American College Theatre Festival gold medallion, but has developed the work of several student playwrights in this year's recent 2022 festival, including the John Cauble award for outstanding short play for *Eat the Rich* by Abby Uphoff.

Whether we are in person or on zoom, the voices of our playwrights must shine. This year's MNPS is pleased to be featuring plays by our award-winning playwrights like recent doctoral graduate Xiomara Cornejo, as well as developing work by professors such as Cherie Sampson from the the School of Visual Studies. And yet, we were so blessed to continue to be able to meet online, via Zoom. every Tuesday night, as usual, despite these challenges--thanks to our wonderful Managing Director, Aidah Nalubowa. And thanks to our fantastic Stage Manager, Clementine Arneson, and our assistant Stage Manager, Hayley Frazer, along with assistance from last year's stage managers (Ellison Land and Austin Hultz) we are able to bring you, for the second time, the 2022 Mizzou New Play Series via Zoom online. While the auditions took place in person, the rehearsals, and performances took place online—so we switched gears efficiently and effectively with very little fuss but definitely with panache—theatre magic at its best!


Since the founding of the Missouri Playwrights Workshop in 1998, more than 97 Mizzou playwrights have gone on to become regional finalists in the Kennedy Center American College Theatre Festival (KCACTF), and 27 have been nationally recognized at the Kennedy Center in Washington, DC. This year was no exception, with three students, Abby Uphoff, Yasmeen Mir, and Dayton Swanson, as finalists in the Region V KCACTF John Cauble One-Act Play Festival, with their plays, respectively, *Eat The Rich, With Our Bodies*, and *Medboy*. In addition, as icing on the cake, our talented Mizzou Phd Alum, Xiomara Cornejo, had her play *Voice of the Voiceless: The Oscar Romero Play* selected as the KCACTF Region 5 National Partners of America

Theatre (NAPAT) Award Recipient and National Semi-Finalist! In addition, *The Lobotomy of Betty Valentine* by Abby Uphoff was given Honorable Mention as part of the KCACTF Region 5 National Partners of American Theatre Full-Length Play Award. Abby's one-act play, *Eat the Rich*, was also invited to next year's 2023 KCACTF Region V Festival as an invited production. Kudos to our winning Mizzou playwrights!

In this year's Mizzou New Play Series, we are producing 21 new plays by playwrights from across the state of Missouri in concert performance in a single week. These plays will be performed as script-in-hand Zoom readings, with just actors, scripts, and screens: you provide the lights, sound, setting, and costume design with your imagination—so listen closely! You are part of the development process, so please join us for a brief discussion of the plays, directly following the performances with the playwright, director, and actors!

And if you have never written a play, then join the students, faculty, and staff here at the Missouri Playwrights Workshop—it's open to any Missouri playwright. MPW meets every Tuesday evening of the fall and spring semesters, currently online at 7pm. The workshops are free and open to the public.
